**Gainesville Fire Rescue** is seeking an **Assistant Chief - Support Services** who will be responsible for managerial, supervisory, and technical work planning and directing both the administrative and technical activities of the Fire Department Support Services Bureau.

Task to be performed may include, but not be limited to coordinating training development and delivery to line and support staff including support of emergency and non-emergency activities of all department personnel; coordinating all active recruitment responsibilities including coordination with Human Resources and Equal Opportunity for all departmental positions; coordinating with Deputy Chiefs to identify training needs for staff in their respective areas; and supervising and coordinating emergency operations, including firefighting, disaster relief, hazardous materials control, extrications, major medical incidents, and other emergency situations. To be considered for this position you must have graduated from an accredited four-year college or university with major course work in fire science, administration, or related subject, supplemented by appropriate technical training, preferably through the National Fire Academy or college/university with a similar curriculum, in Incident Command, Training Program Management, Hazardous Materials, Emergency Medical Services Management, Fire Prevention, and Personnel Supervision and Management.

You must have ten (10) years of experience in a public fire protection department including three (3) years at a district chief level position, or an equivalent combination of training and experience which provide the required knowledge, skills and abilities. You may substitute five (5) years of experience at a training program director level position for three (3) years at district chief level position.

### **CERTIFICATIONS OR LICENSES**

- A valid State of Florida emergency medical technician (EMT) and firefighter certification is required at the time of appointment.
- A valid Florida Driver License is required at the time of appointment.
