SFD is organized into Operations, Fire Prevention, Risk Management and Administrative Divisions.

Appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council, the Fire Chief is the executive administrative officer for the Seattle Fire Department, responsible for directing and coordinating the effective management and efficient functioning of all aspects of the Fire Department, operating an all career fire service model. Within limits established by the State, the Fire Chief shall have complete authority over the organization, its government and discipline, and supervises the department's staff, including all full and part-time employees in all aspects of operations.
